Request for inputs on documents shared during OEWG and call to join Kigali +10 declaration

Dear Sir/Madam,

With MOP38 approaching in Kigali this November, I am writing to remind parties of ongoing activities linked to the tenth anniversary of the Kigali Amendment (KA@10) and to ask for your engagement.

Workshop

On [1 November 2026](#), immediately prior to MOP38, Rwanda is hosting a workshop to mark the 10th anniversary of the Kigali Amendment. All parties and stakeholders are invited to participate. A concept note on the workshop and the first draft programme has been developed, and we would like to invite parties and observers to provide us with feedback and inputs, if possible by [21 September 2026](#).

Exhibition

Rwanda is also hosting an innovation exhibition by industries and organizations. A concept note for the exhibition is also available for feedback and inputs from parties and observers, if possible, by [21 September 2026](#). An invitation to industries and organizations will be sent soon.

Case studies

As mentioned in our presentation on MOP38 preparations at OEWG48, we are also compiling case studies of successful or innovative work parties and other stakeholders have undertaken to implement the Kigali Amendment. If your party or organization has an example worth sharing, we would be glad to include it on the website. The first case studies that have been submitted and posted use a template you're welcome to use, though it isn't required. Case studies may be submitted at any time up to MOP38 and we will keep on adding them to the website for information for all.

Kigali +10 Declaration

As part of marking this anniversary, we are also inviting parties to join the Kigali +10 Declaration to Advance Global Atmospheric Protection. The Declaration looks back on ten years of progress under the Montreal Protocol and the Kigali Amendment and looks forward to a decade of delivery.

Joining is straightforward: a party need only send a short email confirming its government's agreement with the text to mop38@rema.gov.rw. Given the little time remaining before MOP38, we would be grateful to have your endorsement by [30 September 2026](#), and we hope your party will consider adding its voice to this shared statement.
