Introduction

1. The present note covers the matters included in the provisional agenda for the joint meeting of the Bureaux (document UNEP.OzL.Conv.7/Bur.1/1-UNEP/OzL.Pro.19/Bur.1/1). Chapters I and II summarize the actions taken on the decisions adopted by the Conference of the Parties to the Vienna Convention at its seventh meeting and the Nineteenth Meeting of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol, respectively. Chapter III provides an overview of the working documents prepared for the joint eighth meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Vienna Convention and the Twentieth Meeting of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol, in addition to the related preparatory segment of the meeting. Chapter IV provides information on the provisional agenda and the expected road map for the operation of the meetings and related activities that are expected to take place during the week of 16 November in Doha.

I. Action taken on the decisions adopted by the Conference of the Parties to the Vienna Convention at its seventh meeting

2. The table in annex I to the present note provides a broad overview of the decisions adopted by the Conference of the Parties to the Vienna Convention at its seventh meeting and the actions required of and taken by the Secretariat thereon since that time.

3. In accordance with decision VII/2 on the Trust Fund for Financing Activities on Research and Systematic Observations Relevant to the Vienna Convention, the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) has taken the necessary steps to extend the life of the Trust Fund. The UNEP Governing Council in 2007 approved the extension of the Trust Fund to 31 December 2015 to continue supporting monitoring and research activities in developing countries and countries with economies in transition.

4. Several Parties have contributed to the Trust Fund since its inception. The latest report on the status of contributions is contained in document UNEP/OzL.Conv.8/5.

5. The Secretariat and the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) have continued to cooperate with regard to the Trust Fund in accordance with the terms contained in the memorandum of understanding between UNEP and WMO on the institutional arrangements for making decisions on allocation of funds under the Trust Fund. Cooperation has been excellent and, as a result of the contributions made by several Parties, the second and third activities under the Fund (calibration of Brewer spectrophotometers in Nepal and Indonesia, respectively) have been carried out successfully through WMO. A comprehensive report on those activities was sent to the Parties in May 2008, together with the Secretariat's annual letter inviting Parties and international organizations to contribute to the Trust Fund. The letter also contained a brochure on capacity-building for ozone monitoring in developing countries to inform Parties of the priority ozone-monitoring activities that require financing and to give an idea of the magnitude of the funds required.

II. Actions taken on the decisions adopted by the Nineteenth Meeting of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol

6. The table in annex II to the present note provides a broad overview of the decisions adopted by the Nineteenth Meeting of the Parties and the actions required of and taken by the Secretariat thereon since that time.

7. Following the adoption of decision XIX/6 on adjustments to the Montreal Protocol with regard to hydrochlorofluorocarbons (HCFCs), in which the Parties agreed to accelerate the phase-out of production and consumption of HCFCs, the United Nations Secretary-General, as the depositary of the Montreal Protocol, communicated those adjustments to all Parties on 14 November 2007. The adjustments entered into force and became binding to all Parties on 14 May 2008, six months having elapsed from the date of circulation of the communication by the depositary.

III. Overview of working documents prepared for the joint eighth meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Vienna Convention and the Twentieth Meeting of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol

8. The list of documents that will be available for the joint meeting is included as annex III to the present note. In summary, the provisional agenda and annotated provisional agenda for the joint meeting were dispatched to the Parties in September, followed by a note by the Secretariat (document UNEP/OzL.Conv.8/2-UNEP/OzL.Pro.20/2) intended to provide Parties with background information on the issues on the agenda, including, where relevant, a brief description of related activities that took place during the twenty-eighth meeting of the Open-ended Working Group.

9. New information since that meeting is presented in a number of new documents and reports. At the Parties' request, the Technology and Economic Assessment Panel Replenishment Task Force has prepared a supplemental report on replenishment of the Multilateral Fund for the period 2009–2011. In addition, the Methyl Bromide Technical Options Committee will issue a new document in October 2008 containing, among other things, its recommendations on nominations for critical-use exemptions.

10. Concerning budget issues, the Secretariat has prepared proposed budgets for 2009–2011 for the Vienna Convention and a budget for 2009 for the Montreal Protocol. In addition, a number of recommendations made by the Ozone Research Managers at their seventh meeting, based on their review of national research plans, will be submitted for consideration by the Parties. As noted in annex IV to the present note, the Secretariat will provide a number of background documents that the Parties may refer to in their deliberations, if necessary.

IV. Review of the agenda and road map for the operation of the upcoming meetings

11. As on the past three occasions on which the Conference of the Parties has met concurrently with the Meeting of the Parties, a joint agenda has been prepared covering both the joint preparatory segment of the meeting and the joint high-level segment. The agenda for the preparatory segment includes a review of the currently known substantive issues that are expected to be taken up during the high-level segment. For the Montreal Protocol, those issues include decisions on essential uses, critical uses, the replenishment of the Multilateral Fund and the Secretariat budget. In addition, the Implementation Committee will meet for three days immediately before the meeting of the joint Bureaux and its report is likely to include a number of recommended decisions on compliance-related matters. The Secretariat expects to have the report of the Implementation Committee available in the United Nations official languages for consideration at the preparatory segment as early as possible. The provisional agenda of the preparatory segment also includes, for the Vienna Convention, an item on the status of ratifications, the recommendations of the seventh meeting of the Ozone Research Managers and the Secretariat budget.

12. On the basis of both tradition and expedience, the co-chairs of the Open-ended Working Group will oversee the joint preparatory segment of the meeting, which is scheduled to begin on Sunday, 16 November 2008. After the opening of the high-level segment, the meeting may revert, on occasion, to the preparatory segment, as may be deemed useful to enable that segment to complete its work and transmit it to the high-level segment.

13. The opening of the high-level segment on 19 November will be chaired jointly by the presidents of the bureaux of the Vienna Convention and the Montreal Protocol, who will sit ceremonially until new presidents are elected. In accordance with the historic sequencing of positions, the bureau of the eighth meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Vienna Convention is expected to be composed thus: the President will be elected from among the group of Asian and Pacific States, the Rapporteur from the group of African States and the three vice-presidents from the groups of Eastern European, Latin American and Caribbean and Western European and other States. The bureau of the Twentieth Meeting of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol is expected to be composed thus: the President will be elected from among the group of Eastern European States, the Rapporteur from the Asian and Pacific States and the three vice-presidents from the groups of African, Latin American and Caribbean and Western European and other States.

14. The newly elected presidents will then guide the Parties through the agenda on the understanding that the work of contact groups established under the preparatory segment may continue in parallel with the high-level plenary sessions in an effort to resolve any outstanding issues by Thursday, 20 November, when the decisions from the preparatory segment must be adopted. To observe the legal separation between the Conference of the Parties and the Meeting of the Parties, decisions will be adopted with reference to the relevant governing body.

V. Other matters

15. At the time of writing, the Secretariat had no further issues that it wished to bring to the attention of the joint meeting of the bureaux. Members of the bureaux may wish to raise other issues during the present meeting.
