

**Display of information about methyl bromide alternatives
at international Montreal Protocol meeting**

**Request for suppliers to send display materials about their products
- methyl bromide alternatives -
for display at 18th Meeting of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol
30 October to 3 November 2006, New Delhi, India**

Display about alternative products

Companies are invited to send information materials for a display about alternatives to ozone-depleting substances such as methyl bromide. Alternatively, companies may come to the meeting and set up their own displays about products and services, if they wish. There is no charge for display space.

The display will take place at the Vigyan Bhavan Conference Venue in New Delhi, India, on 30 October to 3 November 2006, to coincide with international meetings of the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer (18th Meeting of the Parties).

Tell us if you plan to send information for display

Please inform Ms Martha Leyva of the Ozone Secretariat (email: martha.leyva@unep.org) by 18 October 2006, if you intend to send (or bring) information materials.

What type of information to send?

Display materials can include any or all of the following: commercial product leaflets, flyers, brochures, website details, business cards, posters, CDs, photos with captions, diagrams, or any other materials that explain your products or services.

Examples of useful information:

- description of your product or product range (relevant to methyl bromide alternatives)
- list of crops/uses and pest species for which your product is suitable
- list of countries and crops/uses where your product is registered and/or used
- data about crop yields or results of alternatives compared to methyl bromide
- cost of alternative system, compared to methyl bromide
- examples (or case studies) about farms or companies who use your products
- lists of suppliers and/or website details

The meeting participants are mainly government policy officers from 190 countries of the world. A number of agricultural specialists will also attend, as well as international agencies that implement projects for phasing out methyl bromide in developing countries.

Dates

The display will run from 10 a.m. Monday 30 October and is expected to finish around 6 p.m. Friday, 3 November. Please ensure your information materials arrive at the Ozone Cell of the Ministry of Environment and Forests, India Habitat Centre,

India by Wednesday 25 October, so we can set up the display on Sunday 29 October. You are welcome to set up your own display on Sunday 29 October starting at 10 a.m.

Facilities

The display will be in the Exhibition Hall of Vigyan Bhavan Conference Venue, near the Plenary Hall where the Montreal Protocol meeting takes place. The display will be set up on display boards (approx. 140 x 90 cm) and tables (approx. 180 x 90 cm). Alternatively, companies can bring their own display boards, lights, booths, etc, if they wish. Booths of about 2 x 1.5 meters can be set up, but smaller pop-up displays are preferable because they take less space.

If you intend to come in person, it is necessary to register for the Protocol meeting

Company representatives that intend to come to New Delhi need to register before the meeting using the Pre-Registration Form, as soon as possible. The Pre-Registration form is found in the Ozone Secretariat website:
