SUBJECT: Stockpiles of pharmaceutical-grade CFCs potentially available for export – Decision XXIV/3

Dear Mr. González:

We are pleased to provide information in accordance with paragraph 4 of Decision XXIV/3 that encouraged parties with stockpiles of pharmaceutical grade CFCs potentially available for export to parties with essential-use exemptions in 2013, to notify the ozone Secretariat of such quantities and of a contact point. The following information on stockpiles of CFCs available was provided to the Medical Technical Options Committee in a letter from Boehringer Ingelheim Pharmaceuticals, Inc. and Honeywell International on March 1, 2013.


