*Report of the Secretariat*

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The present report contains information received by the Secretariat (as at 20 August 1993) pursuant to Article 7 (Reporting of Data) of the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer. The report is prepared by the Secretariat for consideration by the Fifth Meeting of the Parties in accordance with Article 12 (c) of the Protocol and decision IV/17 C adopted at the Fourth Meeting of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol.

II. STATUS OF RATIFICATION OF THE MONTREAL PROTOCOL AND  
THE LONDON AND COPENHAGEN AMENDMENTS

2. As at 20 August 1993, 123 States and the European Economic Community (EEC) had ratified the Montreal Protocol and 67 States and EEC had ratified the London Amendment while the Copenhagen Amendment had been ratified by six States.

III. REPORTING OF DATA FOR 1991 AND 1992

3. All Parties are required by Article 7 to report to the Secretariat the relevant data for each year. A third reminder was sent to the Parties in May 1993 to report 1991 and 1992 data. The format to be used for reporting data was also sent to the Parties. In accordance with Article 7, paragraph 4, of the Protocol as amended at London States members of the European Community are required to report to the Secretariat only the data on production of controlled substances. The Community-wide consumption data is reported by EC.

4. The status of reporting of data by the Parties under Article 7 for the years 1991 and 1992 is as follows:

## IV. REMARKS ON THE DATA SUBMITTED

5. According to paragraph 1 of Article 7 of the Protocol, each Party should provide to the Secretariat statistical data on production, imports and exports of each of the controlled substances in Annex A for the year 1986 within three months of becoming a Party. The following Parties, have failed to submit the data required:

Barbados, Belarus, Botswana, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Costa Rica, Gambia, Guinea, India, Iran (Islamic Republic of), Italy, Maldives, Mauritius, Niger, Pakistan, Papua New Guinea, Russian Federation, Saint Kitts and Nevis, Slovenia, Swaziland, Togo, Trinidad and Tobago, Uganda, Ukraine and Zimbabwe.

6. Only 46 Parties (26 non-Article 5 and 20 Article 5) have provided complete data and/or information for 1991. Twenty-eight Parties did not report at all. All the Parties operating under Article 5 that have reported 1991 data show a per capita annual consumption level of less than 0.3 kilograms. China and Venezuela are the only Parties operating under Article 5 that have reported production data for 1991.

7. The Parties that did not report their 1991 data are: Argentina, Bangladesh, Brazil, Burkina Faso, Belarus, Cameroon, Chile, Costa Rica, Czechoslovakia before it ceased to exist on 1 January 1993), Fiji, Gambia, Guatemala, Iran (Islamic Republic of), Italy, Kenya, Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Luxembourg, Maldives, Mexico, Nigeria, Panama, Russian Federation, Singapore, Spain, Syrian Arab Republic, Togo, Trinidad and Tobago, Uganda, Ukraine, United Arab Emirates and Zambia.

8. As can be seen from table 7 in section XIII below, 23 Parties (9 non-Article 5 and 14 Article 5) have so far reported complete data for 1992. The 1992 data from Solomon Islands, which became a Party to the Protocol in 1993 but had earlier reported the data pursuant to decision IV/17 C of the Fourth Meeting of the Parties, has been included in that table. The 1992 population data for Slovakia are not available and therefore the per capita consumption is not shown. All Parties required to report 1992 data will have to do so before the end of September 1993 in order to comply with the reporting requirements under Article 7 of the Protocol.

9. The 1989 and 1990 data reports contain additional data received from those Parties that had not previously reported. For 1989, data and/or information from Bulgaria, China, Cuba, Ireland, Jamaica, Kuwait and Malta has been reported and published in the data report for that year (see section XIV below, table 1). Data and/or information for 1990 has been received from Bulgaria, European Economic Community, Greece, China, Cuba, Jamaica, Malta and Sri Lanka (see section XIV below, table 2). Additional data reports from the following Parties for the control period 1 July 1990-30 June 1991 have been received and included in table 4: Belgium, European Economic Community, France, Greece, Liechtenstein, Poland, Sweden and United Kingdom.

10. Under the London Amendment, which entered into force on 10 August 1992, all Parties are to report data on the substances listed in Annexes B and C no later than three months after the date on which the provisions relating to Annex B substances come into force for them. The data reported by some Parties in fulfilment of this requirement together with the data relating to Annex B and Annex C substances for subsequent years have been incorporated in the respective annual reports for those Parties. Poland and Yugoslavia, two Parties which have not ratified the London Amendment to the Protocol, have reported the 1989 data (see section XIV below, table 8).

#### V. COMPLIANCE WITH THE CONTROL MEASURES

11. The compliance with the control measures under Article 2 by those Parties which have reported the data for the control periods 1 July 1989-30 June 1990, 1 July 1990-30 June 1991 and 1 July 1991-31 December 1992 may be seen from tables 3 (data for the control period 1 July 1989-30 June 1990), 4 (data for the control period 1 July 1990-30 June 1991) and 5 (data for the control period 1 July 1991-31 December 1992), which are contained in section XIV below.

12. For the year 1991, all the Parties not operating under Article 5 have shown reductions in consumption beyond the percentages mandated by the Protocol. The average reduction in consumption was by 45 per cent with Austria and Sweden recording nearly 80 per cent reduction. The production also decreased by 45 per cent, the maximum decrease recorded by France of nearly 62 per cent. Of the Parties operating under Article 5, only Croatia, Ecuador, Egypt, Malta, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Turkey, Venezuela and Yugoslavia have shown a decrease in the consumption of controlled substances. Others have shown increases. The highest increases are recorded by Thailand (200 per cent), China (99 per cent) and Tunisia (80 per cent). The overall increase of consumption in the Parties operating under Article 5 is 54 per cent. These Parties, however, have a grace-period of 10 years and the control measures are applicable to them only from 1 January 1999. These Parties accounted for less than 10 per cent of the total consumption in 1986. In 1991, however, they accounted for nearly 20 per cent of the total consumption. On the whole, it can be observed that all the Parties which reported data have complied with the control measures of the Protocol. The Parties not operating under Article 5 which have not reported i.e. Belarus, Italy, Luxembourg, Russian Federation, Singapore, Ukraine and United Arab Emirates are yet to demonstrate their compliance.

#### VI. DATA REPORTED BY NON-PARTIES TO THE PROTOCOL

13. The data submitted by Colombia for the baseline years 1986 (Annex A substances), 1989 (Annex B and Annex C substances), and calendar years 1990 and 1991 in fulfilment of Article 4, paragraph 8, of the Protocol are contained in table 8 in section XIV below. Under decision IV/17 B of the Fourth Meeting of the Parties, Colombia was allowed to operate under Article 4, paragraph 8, until the date on which the Protocol and its Amendment enter into force for Colombia.

14. Pursuant to decision IV/17 C (Application of trade measures under

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Article 4 to non-Parties to the Protocol) of the Fourth Meeting of the Parties, the following non-Parties to the Montreal Protocol had by 31 March 1993 communicated to the Secretariat, the data and/or information called for in that decision: Comoros, Congo, Dominican Republic, Gabon, Guyana, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Lithuania, Madagascar, Mali, Myanmar, Suriname, and Viet Nam. The data and information reported by these non-Parties were communicated to all Parties in April and May 1993.

15. There follows a summary of the data and/or information received from each of the above-mentioned non-Parties. The actual data are attached to this report in table 9 in section XIV below.

  - Is a developing country with per capita consumption of less than 0.3 kg.;
  - Did not state whether it is in compliance with Article 4.
- MYANMAR
- Did not report the 1986 baseline consumption data for Annex A substances;

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- Did not report the 1989 baseline consumption data for Annexes B and C substances;
  - Reported the 1992 consumption data for Annexes A, B and C substances;
  - Stated it is in compliance with Articles 2 and 4;
  - Is a developing country with per capita consumption of less than 0.3 kg.
- SURINAME
- Reported that annual imports of CFCs is estimated to be 8.6 tonnes per annum;
  - Is a developing country with per capita consumption of less than 0.3 kg.;
  - Did not state whether it is in compliance with Article 4.
- VIET NAM
- Reported estimated 1986 baseline consumption data for Annex A substances;
  - Reported the 1991 consumption data substances in Annexes A, B and C substances;
  - Stated it is in compliance with Article 4;
  - Is a developing country with per capita consumption of less than 0.3 kg.

16. The data from other non-Parties that had reported data pursuant to decision IV/17 C but which subsequently ratified the Montreal Protocol and became Parties prior to the preparation of this report, have been treated as reports from Parties.

17. The following Parties to the Montreal Protocol but non-Parties to the London Amendment had by 31 March 1993 reported the data and/or information to the Secretariat pursuant to decision IV/17 C of the Fourth Meeting of the Parties.

- BELGIUM
- Reported the 1989 baseline production data for Annexes B and C substances;
  - Reported the data for Annex B and Annex C substances for the control periods July 1990-June 1991 and July 1991-December 1992;
  - Is in compliance with Articles 2, 2A-2E and 4 of the Protocol.
- HONG KONG
- Reported the 1986 baseline consumption data for Annex A substances;
  - Reported the 1989 baseline consumption data for Annex B and Annex C substances;
  - Reported the data for Annex A substances for the control periods July 1989-June 1990, July 1990-June 1991 and July 1991-December 1992;

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- Stated it is in compliance with Articles 2, 2A-2E and 4 of the Protocol.
- JORDAN - Reported the 1989 baseline consumption data for Annex B and Annex C substances;
- Reported the 1992 data for Annex A and Annex B substances;
- Is in compliance with Articles 2, 2A-E and 4.
- MALTA - Reported data for Annex A substances but did not report for Annex B and Annex C substances.
- NICARAGUA - Reported the cost of importing controlled substances in United States dollars but did not report actual data for the substances imported;
- Stated to be in compliance with Articles 2, 2A-2E and 4.
- POLAND - Reported the 1989 baseline production and consumption data for Annex B and Annex C substances;
- Stated it is in compliance with Articles 2, 2A-2E and 4 of the Protocol.
- SUDAN - Reported consumption data for Annex B and Annex C substances for the year 1986 but not 1989 (baseline year);
- Has a per capita consumption of Annex B substances of less than 0.2 kg., as specified in Article 5.
- TURKEY - Reported the 1989 baseline consumption data for Annex B and Annex C substances;
- Reported the 1992 consumption data for Annexes B and C substances;
- Is in compliance with Articles 2, 2A-2E and 4.
- URUGUAY - Reported the 1992 consumption data for Annexes B and C;
- Has a per capita consumption of Annex B substances of less than 0.2 kg., as specified in Article 5.
- YUGOSLAVIA - Reported the 1989 baseline consumption data for Annexes B and C substances;
- Has a per capita consumption of Annex B substances of less than 0.2 kg., as specified in Article 5.

The baseline data for substances listed in Annexes B and C from Hong Kong, Poland and Yugoslavia is contained in table 8 in section XIV below.

#### VII. PROBLEMS OF PARTIES IN REPORTING DATA

18. The Parties not operating under Article 5 that have consistently failed to report data to the Secretariat are Belarus, Italy and Ukraine. In addition, the Russian Federation has not reported data since it

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succeeded to the former Soviet Union. In spite of many reminders sent to these Parties to report, there has been no response so far.

19. Many developing countries have consistently been unable to report data to the Secretariat. For the few that have reported data without the assistance from the Multilateral Fund or other external sources, the quality and accuracy of their data is not good. Most of those data are aggregated estimates based on patchy sources of information in those countries. The UNEP, UNDP, and World Bank, the implementing agencies of the Multilateral Fund, have taken up preparation of country programmes in the following countries some of which have been completed and others are ongoing:

- UNDP - Bangladesh, Cuba, India, Indonesia, Iran, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Trinidad and Tobago and Uruguay;
  - Data reports have been received from Cuba, Philippines, Sri Lanka and Uruguay;
- UNEP - Algeria, Barbados, Botswana, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Fiji, Gambia, Guatemala, Malawi, Maldives, Mauritius, Panama, Syrian Arab Republic, Togo, Uganda and Zimbabwe.;
  - Data report has been received from Malawi only.
- WORLD BANK - Argentina, Brazil, China, Ecuador, Egypt, Jordan, Mexico, Nigeria, Thailand, Turkey, Venezuela, Tunisia and Yugoslavia;
  - Data reports have been received from all of these countries although some data were reported prior to the approval of country programmes and therefore may not be very accurate.

20. Data reported from Parties where country programmes have been completed is of good quality. It is expected that with more country programmes being taken up in Article 5 countries they will be able to report the data regularly and with a fair degree of accuracy.

#### VIII. OBSERVATIONS BY THE IMPLEMENTATION COMMITTEE ON DATA REPORTING

21. At its fifth meeting, held in Geneva on 9 March 1993, the Implementation Committee discussed the status of reporting for 1991 and the previous years and expressed serious concern at the non-reporting of data by many Parties. It recalled decision IV/5 of the Fourth Meeting of the Parties regarding the non-compliance procedure and the mandate of the Implementation Committee. It requested the Secretariat to contact each of the Parties that had not reported their data expressing the concern of the Implementation Committee in the light of its mandate as approved by the Fourth Meeting of the Parties.

22. The Committee expressed particular concern at the non-receipt of production data from some of the Parties members of the European Community (Belgium, Greece, Italy and Portugal) and 1991 consumption data from the Commission of the European Communities, in view of their significant production and consumption of the controlled substances and their obligation to phase out the production and consumption very shortly in the light of the Copenhagen adjustments to the Protocol. The Committee decided to invite a representative of the Commission to its next meeting

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(26 August 1993) for an exchange of views on the issue. The Commission might also be requested to help encourage all members of the Communities to report their production data.

23. The Committee then discussed the status of reporting from the central and eastern European countries. It expressed its serious concern regarding the non-reporting by many of those countries. It noted the information provided by the Secretariat that a European ministerial conference would be held shortly to review the Environmental Action Programme for Central and Eastern Europe (see para. 24 below). The Committee requested the Secretariat to follow up on the matter and report to it at its next meeting.

24. At the Lucerne Ministerial Conference on the Environment (28-30 April 1993), the Ministers and the EC Commissioner endorsed the Environment Action Programme for Central and Eastern Europe (EAP) and instruments to support its implementation, thus achieving its main goal. No firm financial commitments were however made. Several Governments indicated the likelihood of support. With regard to the phase-out of ozone-depleting substances (ODS), the meeting requested the central and eastern European countries to focus on the aerosol and flexible foam sectors where ODS use can be eliminated at low cost, and prepare national recovery/reclamation/recycling strategies. They should also review national legislation and strengthen institutional and technical capacity. It is hoped that this Programme will catalyse action by the countries of central and eastern Europe and result in better data reporting.

25. The situation of non-reporting by most Parties operating under Article 5, paragraph 1, was also discussed by the Committee. It noted that even some of the countries whose country programmes had been approved by the Executive Committee had not reported their data. It resolved to request the Fund Secretariat and the implementing agencies to provide reports at the Committee's next meeting on the extent to which their activities in Article 5 countries had helped to create the necessary conditions for the fulfilment of their reporting obligations. It was also resolved to invite the Fund Secretariat and the implementing agencies of the Fund to send representatives to the next meeting of the Implementation Committee to consider those issues, including the training programmes of the Fund which could assist the Article 5 Parties to report promptly. The Fund Secretariat was also requested to comment on regional efforts, on the lines of the United Nations Development Programmes/Swedish International Development Agency project for members of the Association of South East Asian Nations (ASEAN).

26. Following the meeting of the Implementation Committee, in May 1993 the Secretariat sent another reminder to all Parties that had not yet reported data. In response to the serious concern raised by the Implementation Committee at the non-reporting of data by many Parties, Austria, Bahrain, Belgium, Bulgaria, Canada, China, Croatia, EEC, Egypt, Ghana, Greece, Japan, Malawi, Malta, Netherlands, Philippines, Poland, South Africa, Switzerland, Thailand and United States of America reported their respective data which indicate that they are complying with the Montreal Protocol. Other data received are as indicated in the attached tables. In addition, Portugal informed the Secretariat that it does not produce controlled substances and therefore has fulfilled the reporting requirement. According to Article 7, paragraph 4, of the Protocol as amended in 1990, the Community-wide consumption data is reported by EEC. Implementing agencies and the Fund Secretariat have been invited to attend the next meeting of the Implementation Committee. The Committee will hold its sixth meeting in Geneva on 26 August 1993 to consider this report and its comments will be communicated to all Parties prior to the Fifth Meeting of the Parties as document UNEP/OzL.Pro/ImpCom/6/3.

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IX. STATUS OF DEVELOPING COUNTRIES AS PARTIES  
OPERATING UNDER ARTICLE 5

27. As on 20 August 1993, 79 Parties out of the total 123 Parties to the Protocol had been classified as developing countries under decision I/12 (E) of the First Meeting of the Parties. Thirty-nine Parties were categorized as operating under Article 5 of the Protocol because they have consumption of less than 0.3 kilograms per capita of the controlled substances in Annex A (see Annex I to the present report). The 40 developing countries which have provided incomplete or no data have been temporarily classified as operating under Article 5 (see Annex II). However, their status will be re-evaluated after receipt of complete data.

Bahrain and Malta which had previously been classified as not operating under Article 5 have been classified as operating under that Article after reporting data to the Secretariat which indicate that their per capita consumption has fallen below 0.3 kilograms. Brunei Darussalam, Republic of Korea, Kuwait, Saudi Arabia, Singapore and United Arab Emirates are the only developing countries categorized as not operating under Article 5. Their status could change once their per capita consumption falls below the ceiling prescribed in Article 5.

X. POPULATION DATA

28. Except where a Party has furnished population figures, the population data used to calculate the per capita consumption of the controlled substances for each of the Parties for the years 1991, 1992 and previous years are from the estimates contained in the *Population and Vital Statistics Report* and the *World Population Prospects: 1992 revision*, published by the United Nations.

XI. CONFIDENTIALITY OF DATA

29. According to decision II/9, adopted by the Second Meeting of the Parties, production, import and export data but not consumption data are treated as confidential. Therefore, although Parties are required and have been reporting complete data on each of the controlled substances, in the present report the data are expressed only by groups of substances for each Party.

XII. REPORTING STATUS UNDER ARTICLE 4

30. Decision III/16 of the Third Meeting of the Parties encouraged the Parties to inform the Secretariat of the implementation of Article 4 of the Protocol. The Secretariat has received the following information since the publication of information under this Article in the last report (UNEP/OzL.Pro.4/6):

(a) *Hungary*. Since 1990 all imports and exports of controlled substances are supervised by prescribing special permits. All existing and potential trading partners with Hungary have already ratified the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer. Hungary is in full compliance with Article 4 of the Protocol;

(b) *Germany*. The provisions of Article 4 of the Montreal Protocol have been implemented by Article 5 to 9 of EEC Council Regulation No. 594/91 of 4 March 1991 on substances that deplete the ozone layer.

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Since the Regulation is binding in its entirety to all member States of the European Communities, no separate implementation by German law was necessary. The Regulation has been amended to better reflect the decisions of the Second Meeting of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol and to accelerate the phase out of the ozone-depleting substances;

(c) *Greece* is fully implementing EEC Regulations 594/91 and 3952/92;

(d) *Turkey*. Each controlled substance in Annex A, Annex B and Annex C has been given a special customs tariff number for the purpose of banning the import of controlled substances from non-Parties to the Protocol. A law banning importation of controlled substances from non-Parties was promulgated on 6 August 1992 and entered into force on 19 December 1992.

### XIII. REPORTING STATUS UNDER ARTICLE 9

31. The Secretariat has received the following information on research, development, public awareness and exchange of information since the publication of the last report (UNEP/OzL.Pro.4/6):

(a) *Germany* organized an international conference on alternatives to CFCs and halons in Berlin from 24 to 26 February 1993 on the exchange of information on scientific, technical, socio-economic and legal implications of phasing out ozone depleting substances. Some experts from developing countries were sponsored by the German Government. It discussed the "Ten CFC Commandments for Refrigeration Men" at the Pilot Workshop for CFCs organized by the UNEP Regional Office for Asia and the Pacific in Bangkok, from 30 March to 2 April 1992;

(b) *Greece*, consistent with EEC Regulations 594/91 and 3952/92, has encouraged the local producers of controlled substances to transfer any available published information to their partners in developing countries. It is encouraging the promotion of public awareness on the environmental effects of the controlled substances through the universities, the press, the media and related seminars.
