REPORTING REQUIREMENTS UNDER THE PROTOCOL AND PURSUANT TO
REQUESTS FOR DATA BY MEETINGS OF THE PARTIES

Legislative basis for reporting

1. To verify implementation of one part of Articles 2A - 2H
2. Article 7
3. Article 9
4. Article 2, paragraphs 5,5 bis 6,7

Information to be provided

- Increased (annual) production of each ODS to meet the basic domestic needs of Article 5 Parties
- Production, imports and exports of each of the controlled substances
- Amounts used for feedstock
- Amounts destroyed
- Imports from and exports to non-Parties
- Summary of activities (every two years)
- Transfer or addition of production (as and when it occurs)

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5. Decision IV/17 A, paragraph 1 - Information on the implementation of Article 4
6. Decision IV/24, paragraph 2 - Import and export of recycled and used controlled substances
7. Decision V/15 - Information relevant to international halon bank management (to UNEP IE PAC)
8. Decision V/25 and VI/14 A - Parties supplying ODS to Article 5 Parties provide annually summary of requests from importing Parties
9. Decision VI/19, paragraph 4 - List of reclamation facilities and their capacities
10. Decision VII/9, paragraph 4 - Types, quantities and destinations of exports of ODS
11. Decision VII/30 - Importing countries to report to the Secretariat on the volumes of controlled substances imported for feedstock
12. Decision VII/32 - Report on measures taken to regulate import and export of products and equipment containing Annex A and Annex B substances and technology used in their manufacture
