ANNOTATED PROVISIONAL AGENDA

1. Opening of the meeting

The fourth session will be opened at 10.30 a.m. on Monday,  
22 October 1984 at Palais des Nations, Geneva.

2. Election of officers

The meeting will elect a chairman, a vice-chairman and a rapporteur.

3. Organization of work

The meeting will decide on how the work of the fourth session should be organized. It is suggested that the work of the meeting will normally be conducted in Plenary with provision for small working groups as necessary, it being understood that interpretation services are provided for one meeting at a time.

4. Consideration of a draft convention for the protection of the ozone layer

5. Consideration of a draft protocol concerning control of chlorofluorocarbons

The mandate of the meeting, as laid down in part I of Governing Council decision 12/14 of 28 May 1984, is to complete work on the convention to the extent possible and to continue to elaborate a possible draft protocol concerning control of chlorofluorocarbons.

The meeting will have before it the following documentation:

- UNEP/WG.94/10 - Report of the Working Group on the second part of its third session (Vienna, 16-20 January 1984);
- UNEP/WG.94/11 - Fourth Revised Draft Convention for the Protection of the Ozone Layer;
- UNEP/WG.94/12 - Second Revised Draft Protocol Concerning Measures to Control, Limit and Reduce the Emissions of Chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs) for the Protection of the Ozone Layer;
- UNEP/WG.94/13 - Financial Implications of the Implementation of the Convention for the Protection of the Ozone Layer: Revised Estimates;
- UNEP/WG.110/2 - Summary of comments received from Governments on the fourth draft convention and second revised draft protocol.

The meeting will also receive a summary of the recommendations of the seventh session of the Co-ordinating Committee on the Ozone Layer (CCOL), scheduled to be held immediately prior to the meeting in Geneva, 15-19 October 1984.

6. Other business

The meeting may consider subsequent steps to be taken to finalize the work of UNEP in this regard.

7. Adoption of the report

The meeting is expected to adopt a report which, through the Executive Director of UNEP, will be brought to the attention of a Diplomatic Conference to be convened in the first quarter of 1985, in accordance with Governing Council decision 12/14 (I).

8. Closure of the meeting

The closure of the meeting is scheduled for the afternoon of Friday, 26 October 1984.
