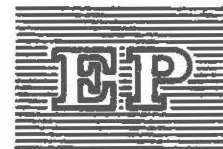

ANNOTATED PROVISIONAL AGENDA

1.9 Opening of the meeting

The meeting will be opened at 10.00 a.m. on Wednesday 20 January 1982 at Stockholm, Sweden by the Executive Director of UNEP, Dr. M.K. Tolba who will invite the Minister of Agriculture and Environment of Sweden to address the meeting.

The Executive Director will then make an opening statement

2. Election of officers

The meeting will elect a chairman, a vice-chairman and a rapporteur.

3. Adoption of the agenda and organization of work

The meeting will be invited to approve the provisional agenda (UNEP/WG.69/1). It is suggested the work of the meeting be normally conducted in Plenary with provision for small working groups as necessary, it being understood that interpretation services are provided for one meeting at a time.

4. Presentation of technical aspects of ozone layer depletion and its impact and general debate

Presentation of technical aspects of ozone layer depletion and its impact, including socio-economic impacts and alternative technology,

will be made by some selected experts in the course of the first day of the meeting. General debate will then follow.

5. Consideration of a global framework convention for the protection of the ozone layer

The mandate of the meeting as laid down in paragraph 1 of the decision 9/13 B of the Governing Council adopted at its ninth session on 26 May 1981 is to initiate work aimed at the elaboration of a global framework convention for the protection of the ozone layer.
