

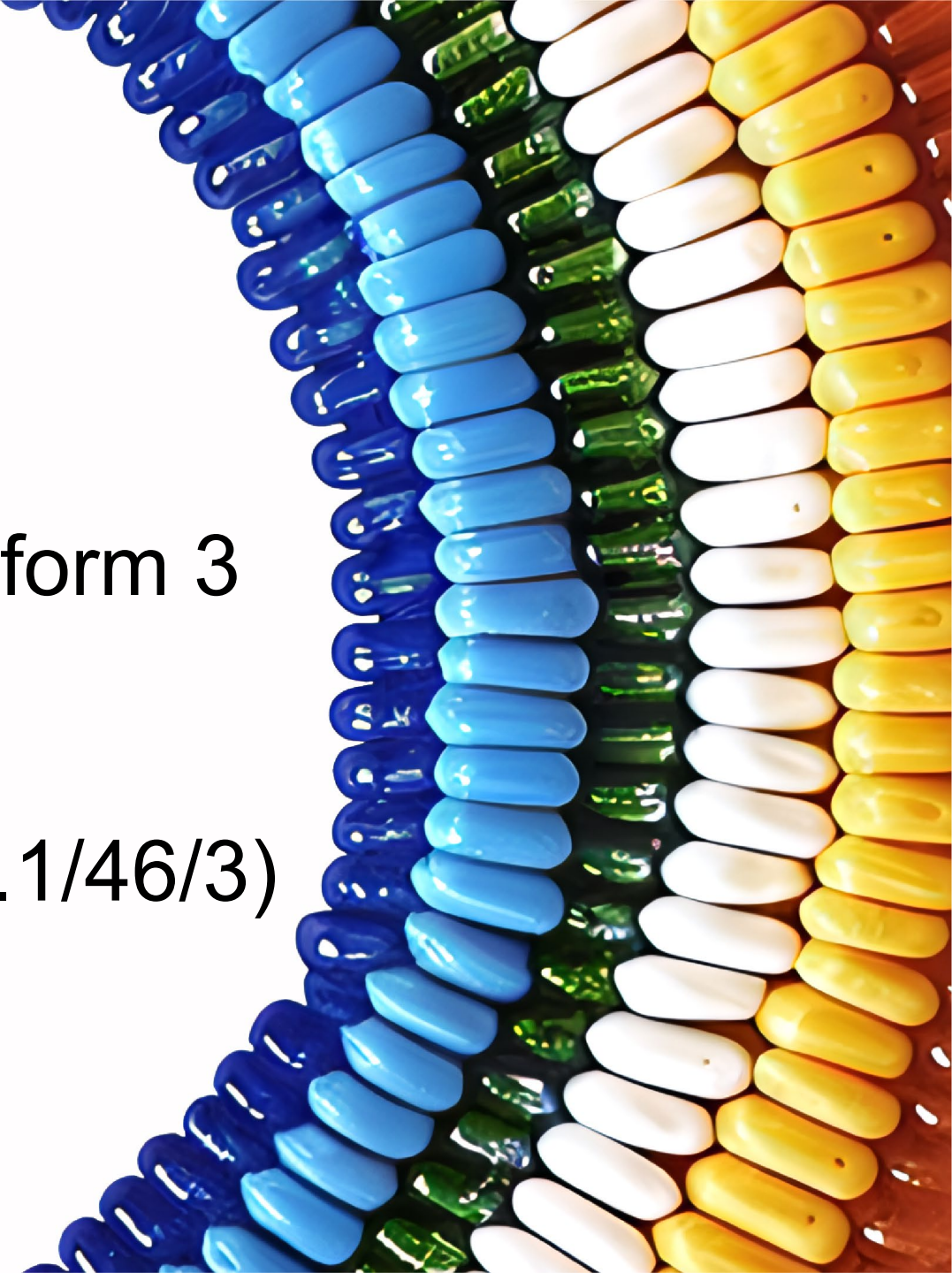

Potential changes to reporting form 3 for reporting on HFC-23

(Document UNEP/OzL.Pro.WG.1/46/3)



Background

- Response to paragraph 3 of decision XXXV/7
- Options for potential changes to reporting form 3, concerning when HFC-23 is generated, destroyed or maintained as stocks.
- Recognize: Information on stocks is not required under Article 7
- Recognize: Stock levels are not part of the compliance regime
- Assumed: To allow accounting for HFC-23 generation
- Assumed: New substances (unused, not recovered)
- Approach: Accounting framework, similar to essential/critical uses

Background (continued)

- Additional consideration:
 - Include a clarification note in data form 3 stating that the amount captured for all uses (column 3) refers to both intentional production and unintentional by-production
- Two options - essentially identical information
 - Differ only in terms of the layout

Option 2: Adding an annex to data form 3

All quantities pertain to new (unused, not recovered) HFC-23

<i>(A) On hand at the start of the year</i>	<i>(B) Quantity imported (obtained from column 3 of data form 1 on imports)</i>	<i>(C) Quantity exported (obtained from column 3 of data form 2 on exports)</i>	<i>(D) Total generation that is captured (obtained from column 3 of data form 3 on “production and HFC-23 generation”)</i>	<i>(E) Quantity used as feedstock</i>	<i>(F) Quantity destroyed</i>	<i>(G) Quantity used for other uses within the country*</i>	<i>(H) On hand at the end of the year</i>

Comments:

Note: **The “Quantity used for other uses within the country” excludes the “Quantity used as feedstock”.
The amount produced for all uses refers to both intentional production and unintentional by-production.*

Option 1: Adding rows to data form 3

Comments:

Note: *The “Quantity used for other uses within the country” excludes the “Quantity used as feedstock”.
 In accounting for HFC-23 generation that is captured or stocks of HFC-23 across years, the following quantities would be required:

- (a) The quantity imported, which is found in column 3 of data form 1 on imports.*
- (b) The quantity exported, which is found in column 3 of data form 2 on exports.*
- (c) The quantity generation that is captured, which is found in column 3 of data form 3 on “production and HFC-23 generation”.*

The amount produced for all uses refers to both intentional production and unintentional by-production.
