Note by the Secretariat

I. Introduction

1. The Bureau of the Twenty-Ninth Meeting of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol will meet at 4 p.m. on Sunday, 4 November 2018, at the Quorum Quito Convention Centre (the Quorum) in Quito. The present note provides information about substantive agenda items 3 and 4 of the provisional agenda for the meeting (UNEP/OzL.Pro.29/Bur.1/1). Section II summarizes information on agenda item 3 regarding the actions taken by the Secretariat with regard to the decisions of the Twenty-Ninth Meeting of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol. Section III provides information relating to the review of the agenda, presentation of a road map for the conduct of the meeting and an overview of documents for the Thirtieth Meeting of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol.

**II. Work to date on the implementation of the decisions of the
Twenty-Ninth Meeting of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol
(agenda item 3)**

2. The table set out in the annex to the present note provides a broad overview of the decisions adopted by the Twenty-Ninth Meeting of the Parties and the actions required of and taken/to be taken by the Secretariat in response thereto.

III. Review of the agenda, presentation of a road map for the conduct of the meeting and overview of the working documents prepared for the Thirtieth Meeting of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol (agenda item 4)

3. The Thirtieth Meeting of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol will be held at the Quorum Quito Convention Centre (the Quorum) in Quito from 5 to 9 November 2018. In accordance with established practice, the meeting will be divided into two segments: a three-day preparatory segment and a two-day high-level segment. The preparatory segment is scheduled to begin at 10 a.m. on Monday, 5 November 2018, while the high-level segment will begin at 10 a.m. on Thursday, 8 November 2018. The online registration system was launched on 31 July and on-site registration will start on Saturday, 3 November, at the venue.

4. The provisional agenda for the Thirtieth Meeting of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol (UNEP/OzL.Pro.30/1) was circulated to the parties in August 2018, and the annotations to the provisional agenda (UNEP/OzL.Pro.30/1/Add.1) will be issued in September 2018. A note by the Secretariat (UNEP/OzL.Pro.30/2) with background information on the issues on the agenda will be posted on the meeting portal in September. An addendum to that note with additional information, that is expected to become available at a later stage, will be issued in October.

5. Detailed information on issues on the agenda is set out in a number of documents that have been posted on the meeting portal at the following link: <http://conf.montreal-protocol.org/meeting/mop/mop30/SitePages/Home.aspx>.

6. The agenda for the preparatory segment includes all the issues that are expected to be taken up during the high-level segment for a decision by the parties. By the time of the preparation of the present note, the Secretariat had not received any requests from parties for issues to be raised under agenda item 17 on other matters. Bureau members may wish to raise other matters during the adoption of the agenda for the meeting.

7. With regard to issues related to the budget, the Secretariat has prepared a proposed revision to the approved budget for 2018 and proposed budgets for 2019 and 2020 of the Trust Fund for the Montreal Protocol (UNEP/OzL.Pro.30/4) and a proposed results-based budget for 2019 and 2020 (UNEP/OzL.Pro.30/4/Add.1). The results-based budget presents two scenarios, namely a zero nominal growth scenario and the proposed budget scenario, together with six main objectives along with their associated expected accomplishments, indicators of achievement, target dates and costing where possible. A financial report for the trust funds for the Vienna Convention for the Protection of the Ozone Layer and the Montreal Protocol for the fiscal year 2017 has also been prepared for consideration by the parties (UNEP/OzL.Pro.30/5).

8. A note by the Secretariat and its addendum (UNEP/OzL.Pro.30/2 and Add.1, respectively) summarize the issues on the agenda for the meeting. The note provides an overview of all the issues covered in the provisional agenda, including the Kigali Amendment to the Montreal Protocol to phase down hydrofluorocarbons; future availability of halons and their alternatives; issues related to exemptions under Articles 2A–2I of the Montreal Protocol; linkages between hydrochlorofluorocarbons (HCFCs) and hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs) in transitioning to low-global-warming-potential alternatives; issues related to energy efficiency while phasing down hydrofluorocarbons; proposed adjustments to the Montreal Protocol on HCFCs for parties not operating under paragraph 1 of Article 5 of the Protocol; and unexpected emissions of trichlorofluoromethane (CFC-11).

9. Other topics on the agenda relate to the issue raised by the United Arab Emirates on eligibility for financial and technical assistance; review of the terms of reference, composition and balance as well as fields of expertise required of the assessment panels and their subsidiary bodies; consideration of senior expert and other nominations by parties to the Technology and Economic Assessment Panel; consideration of the membership of Montreal Protocol bodies for 2019; compliance and data reporting issues in relation to the work and recommended decisions of the Implementation Committee under the Non-Compliance Procedure for the Montreal Protocol; and an update on the situation of the Caribbean islands affected by hurricanes.

10. A list of the working and information documents that will be available for the Thirtieth Meeting of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol, along with background information, may be found in document UNEP/OzL.Pro.30/INF/9.

11. In accordance with established practice, the Co-Chairs of the Open-ended Working Group will oversee the preparatory segment of the meeting. After the opening of the high-level segment, the parties may reconvene the preparatory segment as they deem expedient to allow for the completion of any unfinished business.

12. The opening of the high-level segment on 8 November will be chaired by the President of the Twenty-Ninth Meeting of the Parties, who will conduct the meeting until the parties elect the president of the Thirtieth Meeting of the Parties. In accordance with rule 21 of the rules of procedure for Meetings of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol and the established practice of rotating the posts of president and rapporteur among the regional groups in English alphabetical order, it is expected that the new president of the Thirtieth Meeting of the Parties will be elected from among the Latin American and Caribbean States, the rapporteur from among the Asian-Pacific States and the three vice-presidents from among the African States, Eastern European States and the Western European and other States. The newly elected President will then guide the parties through the agenda on the understanding that the work of contact groups established during the preparatory segment may continue in parallel with the high-level plenary sessions in an effort to resolve any outstanding issues by Friday, 9 November 2018, when the parties are expected to adopt draft decisions.
