REPORT OF THE CREDENTIALS COMMITTEE

On 21 March 1985, the Credentials Committee, having examined the credentials of delegations to the Conference, found the credentials of the representatives of the following countries to be in order:

Algeria; Argentina; Australia; Austria; Belgium; Brazil; Byelorussian SSR; Canada; Chile; Denmark; Egypt; Finland; France; Germany, Federal Republic of; Greece; Italy; Japan; Mexico; Morocco; Netherlands; New Zealand; Nigeria; Norway; Peru; Senegal; Spain; Sweden; Switzerland; Ukrainian SSR; Union of Soviet Socialist Republics; United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland; United States of America; and Venezuela.

The credentials of the delegation of the European Economic Community were also found to be in order.

The Committee noted that representatives of the following countries had submitted credentials authorizing them to attend the Conference as observers:

Bulgaria, China, Indonesia, Tunisia and Uruguay.

At its meeting on 22 March 1985, the Credentials Committee found that the following delegations had credentials in good order which gave them full powers to sign the Vienna Convention:

Argentina; Belgium; Byelorussian SSR; Canada; Chile; Denmark; Egypt; Finland; France; Germany, Federal Republic of; Greece; Italy; Mexico; Netherlands; Norway; Peru; Sweden; Switzerland; Ukrainian SSR; Union of Soviet Socialist Republics; United States of America and European Economic Community.
