Financial report on the trust funds for the Vienna Convention for the Protection of the Ozone Layer and the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer for the biennium 2004–2005 and expenditures for 2005 as compared to the approved budgets

### **Note by the Secretariat**

- 1. Annex I to the present addendum to document UNEP/OzL.Pro.18/4 contains a statement prepared by the Secretariat showing actual expenditures for 2005 as compared to the approved budgets for that year. Annex II reproduces the audited and certified financial report on the trust funds for the Vienna Convention for the Protection of the Ozone Layer and the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer for the biennium 2004–2005 ended 31 December 2005.
- 2. The activities of the Secretariat are financed through the Trust Fund for the Montreal Protocol, the Trust Fund for the Vienna Convention and additional voluntary contributions from individual governments. The total costs in 2005 under the Trust Fund for the Montreal Protocol amounted to \$4,214,368, inclusive of 13 per cent programme support costs of \$484,369, and the total costs under the Trust Fund for the Vienna Convention amounted to \$1,206,996, inclusive of 13 per cent programme support costs of \$138,856.
- 3. Additional contributions were received from the following countries: Canada (CAD 100,000), Finland (EUR 10,000) and Switzerland (USD 50,000) for the organization of the joint seventh meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Vienna Convention and Seventeenth Meeting of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol; Sweden (SEK 350,000) for participation of developing countries in the joint seventh meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Vienna Convention and Seventeenth Meeting of the

Parties to the Montreal Protocol; and the Netherlands (EUR 20,000) and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (EUR 4,500) for the activities of the Co-Chairs of the Technology and Economic Assessment Panel.
