**Twenty-Eighth Meeting of the Parties to the
Montreal Protocol on Substances that
Deplete the Ozone Layer**
Kigali, 10–14 October 2016

Information on illegal trade in ozone-depleting substances reported by the Federated States of Micronesia and Kenya pursuant to paragraph 7 of decision XIV/7

By paragraph 7 of decision XIV/7, the parties to the Montreal Protocol requested the Secretariat to collect any information on illegal trade received from parties and to disseminate it to all parties. The information reported by the Federated States of Micronesia and Kenya to the Secretariat in 2015 and 2016 pursuant to that decision is summarized in the table set out in the annex to the present note.
