

Third update on COVID measures in Thailand

1. Recent changes made by the Royal Thai Government in respect of COVID-19 measures presented here below. Where no update has been made, the measures outlined in the note of 8 June 2022 apply.
 - a) **Effective 1 July 2022**, Thailand Pass (and proof of medical insurance coverage upto USD10,000) is **not required**
2. All participants who intend to participate in the meetings in person are **reminded**:
 - a) They should be fully vaccinated against COVID-19, and:
 - **Funded Participants** are requested to send their vaccination certificates to the Secretariat before the issuance of air tickets for travel.
 - **Non-funded participants** are requested to present their vaccination certificate at the registration desk in Bangkok during collection of meeting badge.
 - b) They should complete the **online self-declaration form** (refer paragraph 16(a) of section V of the Information Note of 8 June 2022) **at least 2 working days** before the start of the meeting. The form is a **one-time** submission and is required for obtaining access to ESCAP premises.
3. Information Note shared on 8 June 2022 will be updated to reflect the above noted changes to the COVID measures in Thailand.
