Presentation of National Reports

1. A total of 59 Parties submitted their national reports on existing and planned activities relating to ozone research and the monitoring, calibration and archiving of measurements; and UV-B monitoring. Under item 9 of the provisional agenda of the Sixth Meeting of the Ozone Research Managers (UNEP/OzL./Conv.ResMgr/6/1) representatives are being requested to make oral presentations of their national reports.

2. Due to time constraints, only 40 Parties will be able to present their reports. The following Parties are being requested to make a presentation:

- Day 1 (Monday, 19 Sept), afternoon session:

Argentina, Armenia, Belarus, Bolivia, Brazil, Bulgaria, Chile, Czech Republic, Denmark, Egypt, Estonia, European Community.

- Day 2 (Tuesday, 20 Sept), morning session:

Fiji, Finland, Germany, Georgia, India, Japan, Lithuania, Malaysia, Morocco, Nigeria, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Panama, Paraguay, Philippines, Poland, Russia.

- Day 2 (Tuesday, 20 Sept), afternoon session: 18 Parties

Slovakia, South Africa, Spain, Switzerland, Turkey, Turkmenistan, United Kingdom, United States of America, Uzbekistan, Vietnam.

3. Allocated time for each presentation is 10 minutes. A possible schedule of the times for the presentations has been indicated above, however, please note that the actual organization of work of the meeting is to be decided at the meeting. The order of the presentations may also be changed if necessary.
